- Star Round and tripod lashing: trucker's hitch

2C. FIRST AID (Scout should know symptoms and first aid for following, or be able to demonstrate the skills shown)

- Tenderfoot Cuts & scratches, blisters, minor burns and scalds, bites and stings of insects and ticks, poisonous snakebite, nosebleed, frostbite and sunburn.
- 2nd Class Hurry cases (stopped breathing, no heartbeat, severe bleeding, choking, and poisoning by mouth), object in eye, rabid animal bite, splinter, nail, fishhook puncture, serious burns, heat exhaustion, shock, heatstroke, dehydration, hypothermia, hyperventilation
- 1st Class Bandage head, upper arm fracture, collarbone or shoulder fracture, sprained ankle, how to transport a person out of a smoke-filled room, how to transport a person with a broken leg (with a helper), five signs of a heart attack, explain CPR
- Star Tell what precautions must be taken for a safe swim, a safe hike
- Life Be able to demonstrate CPR, how to improvise a stretcher and transport a person
- Eagle Be able to teach a first aid skill
